



New preschool students will be assessed for skills that are critical predictors of school success (physical development/motor, language, academic/cognitive, self-help, and social-emotional skills).

Appointments are required: August/September dates TBD

★ Parents will be notified of the screening appointment in writing

Screening Tool Components:

- ★ Student meets 1:1 with the teacher(s) conducting the screening for approximately 20 minutes
- * Parents complete Developmental History Questionnaire
